WI-FI UPDATE By: Doug Ford

The Forest Park WIFI has performed well over the Summer. The only problem we had was with the RV tower, which we had to shut down because of repeated power surges caused by lighting strikes. When the "*CREW*" gets back we will investigate the cause of the failures and put the tower back on-line. Several users had to have adjustment made to connect to the clubhouse. On average during the summer we had 55 users using the system, as of the 10th of Oct. about 75 users.

BOCCE BALL By: Lee Fisher

Some of you returning may have noticed work being done to the bocce ball courts. Well, we have found that annual maintenance of the court which includes adding another coating of Hartru has increased in cost by triple the price. So, the lowest bidder for annual maintenance suggested a one time "fix" for the courts. By combining a couple years budgeted amount for the courts we placed new drains to carry away the flooding rains in the summer and poured 4" of concrete to be covered by carpeting, similar to the mini-golf courts. We have removed the boards which had begun to deteriorate already after recent attempts to refurbish, as well as the lag bolts were rusting.

As with the savings on water from owning our own well, we hope this will limit our maintenance costs to the bocce committee of a new carpet every 3-5 years and provide a smooth solid court for the continued enjoyment of our bocce players. We've been promised it will be ready to play by October 15, 2011. See You Out There.
