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
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## HURRICANE IRMA

## Contractor Tips

Don't get nailed! Many citizens in Florida have fallen victim to dishonest, unlicensed, or improperly licensed contractors. Florida Statute 489 requires all construction contractors to hold a valid contractor's license prior to engaging in contracting. Always require that a contractor show you a valid contracting license before you sign a contract. Some indications that a contractor may be unlicensed include the following:

- \*The contractor requests a large deposit or all the money up front before any work has commenced

- \*The contractor asks you to pull a "homeowner permit"

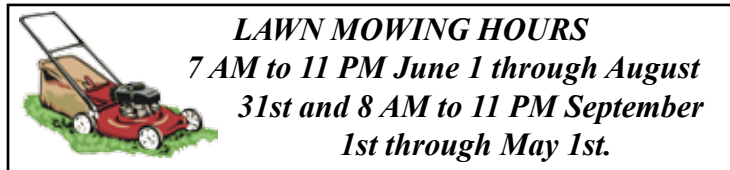
- \*The contractor pressures you to sign a contract today or he/she can't give you this special price

## Verifying Contractor Licenses

To verify the license of a contractor, you may call the State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) at 239-338-2373. The city requires proof of license from contractors who pull permits for properties located in the city, so be sure to require that the contractor pull the permit in his name, not your name. Or you can also go to [www.myfloridalicense.com](http://www.myfloridalicense.com) to look up a contractor to see if they are licensed.

## RV STORAGE AREA

It has come to our attention that people outside the park are coming into the RV/STORAGE area and helping themselves to items that have been thrown away. To some this may be no big deal, but to residents that have a storage spot in that area – it is. If people are taking junk—next thing they might be taking is your valuables.

SO, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY the gates are to remain closed and locked except on Tuesday and Friday during trash pickup. If you need to go into the area, it is your responsibility to lock the gate when you exit (unless another resident is in there) then kindly ask them to lock it up. Also, if you have a spot in the RV AREA and you

are caught on camera not locking the gate, you are at risk of losing your spot.

Also, please pay attention when throwing out junk in the compound. We have found trash in the construction dumpster and construction items in the trash compactor etc.

## A RECENT LETTER FROM WASTE PRO

Bulk waste is any non-vegetative item including but not limited to, appliances, toilets, bathtubs, pool heaters, sinks, bicycles, mattresses, furniture, carpet and other oversized household items.

Bulk waste does not include automotive vehicles, boats, major vehicle components, large amounts of construction debris, vegetative waste or liquid waste. Please place bulk waste in the location designated for this material. Do not place bulk waste in the compactor or dumpster.

Waste Pro does not collect liquid waste or materials that may be hazardous. Materials such as used motor oil, paints, fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, cleaning supplies, batteries, propane tanks and chemicals. Please contact the Lee County Solid Waste Division at 239-533-8000 for proper disposal of these materials or bring them to the Lee County Solid Waste Annex at 6441 Topaz Ct. in Fort Myers. If you have any questions concerning collection services that we provide, please call our office at 239-337-0800.



## FOREST PARK VISITORS WRISTBANDS



Visitors unaccompanied by Forest Park residents must wear wristbands when using park recreational facilities (pool, mini-golf, etc.). The wristbands are now available in the park office (2 per family and additional bands may be requested). The bands stretch but if they are not large enough you may pin them to clothing, attach them to a key chain or just bring them along.

Please remember that all owners are responsible for their visitors who must comply with all Forest Park Rules & Regulations. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation to assist in maintaining the security of our park.

## HAZARDOUS WASTE

Lee County has very strict regulations regarding hazardous material disposal. The Board voted to approve the initiative to have all residents place paint, pesticides, chemicals, florescent bulbs and gas bottles at curbside.

Park employees will pick up these materials on Tuesday and Friday and log them in. These articles will be stored and disposed of in the appropriate manner by staff members.

The rules and regulations have been changed to reflect the process.

### STROKE IDENTIFICATION:

During a BBQ, a woman stumbled and took a little fall – she assured everyone that she was fine (they offered to call paramedics) .....she said she had just tripped over a brick because of her new shoes. They got her cleaned up and got her a new plate of food. While she appeared a bit shaken up, Jane went about enjoying herself the rest of the evening.

Jane's husband called later telling everyone that his wife had been taken to the hospital (at 6:00 PM Jane passed away). She had suffered a stroke at the BBQ. Had they known how to identify the signs of a stroke, perhaps Jane would be with us today. Some don't die. They end up in a helpless, hopeless condition instead. **IT ONLY TAKES A MINUTE TO READ THIS**

A neurologist says that if he can get to a stroke victim within 3 hours, he can totally reverse the effects of a stroke....totally. He said the trick was getting a stroke recognized, diagnosed, and then getting the patient medically cared for within 3 hours, which is tough.

## RECOGNIZING A STROKE

Thank God for the sense to remember the '3' steps, STR

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. Unfortunately, the lack of awareness spells disaster. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke.

Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking three simple questions:

**S \* Ask the individual to SMILE**

**T -- Ask the person to TALK and SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**

**(Coherently) (i.e. Chicken Soup)**

**R -- Ask him/her to RAISE BOTH ARMS.**

If he/she has trouble with any one of these tasks, call 911 immediately and describe the symptoms to the dispatcher.

### NEW SIGN OF A STROKE

Stick out your tongue!! Another sign of a stroke is this: Ask the person to 'stick' out his/her tongue. If the tongue is 'CROOKED', if it goes to one side or the other, that is also an indication of a stroke.

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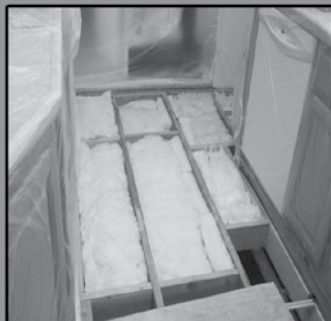


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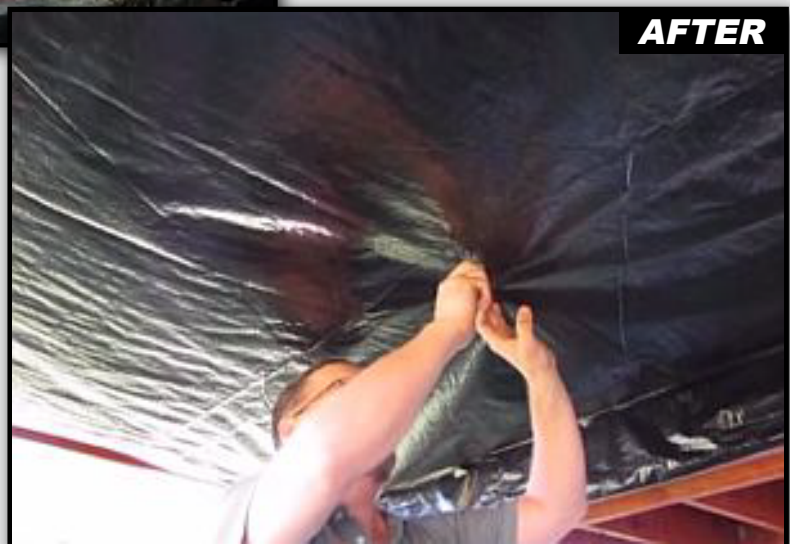
