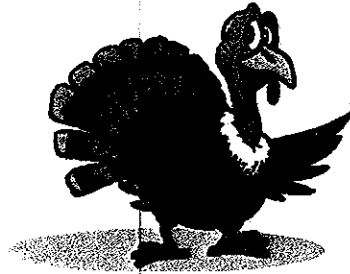

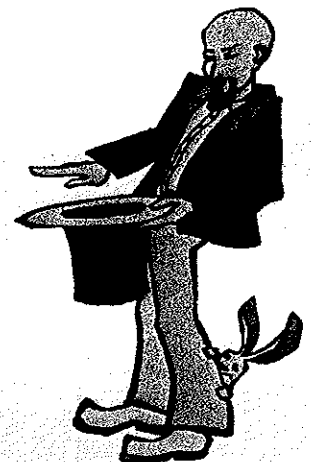
OHIO CLUB
