Heading closer to fall and Many of Us Heading Back to Forest Park By Sandy Corrigan



After a few years, I discovered a very nice restaurant called Rib City and was really impressed with the food and the manager at that time by the name of Penny. We became friends. Rib City was located on Cleveland Avenue, just before you cross the Caloosahatchee Bridge.

As time went on, Rib City went on to become our favorite restaurant for ribs, sweet potato fries and pulled pork (my personal favorite). At that time a mug of

beer was 25 cents on Wednesday nights. So of course Wednesday night became our night for Rib City.

Passed away July 14th 2022


Sandy lived in Forest Park for a number of years and although a very quiet and private person, friends speak of her as being very friendly with a pleasant personality.

FOREST PARK VISITORS WRISTBANDS






