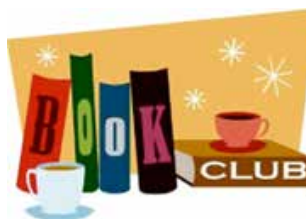

Norman Leon Tybor, age 87, died on September 2, 2022, at his home in North Fort Myers, Florida. Funeral services will be held at St. Alfred's in Taylor, MI on Friday, September 16, 2022, at 10:00.



Beloved husband of the late Alice (nee Maher) Tybor. Devoted father of Christopher A. (Sharon) Tybor, Kathleen E. Tybor, Rebecca A. Tybor, Shawn W. (Yvonne) Tybor, David A. (Lori Twehues), Elizabeth E. (David) Leski, and Heather C. (David) Kirkland. Dear brother of the late Arthur (Sheila) Tybor, Ronald (Sandy) Tybor, late Allen (Delphine), and Clarity (nee Baron) Martin. Loving grandfather and great-grandfather to thirty-one and growing.

Norman was born in Houston, TX on April 2, 1935, to Pauline and Leon Tybor. His father unexpectedly passed away when he was three. A few years later after Pauline remarried Ed Baron of Dearborn, MI, they moved to Detroit. He attended Christ the King in Houston, TX, and graduated from St. Alphonsus High School in Dearborn, MI where he was captain of the basketball team and vice president of his class. Norman held down numerous sales jobs in his early years and also served in the Michigan National Guard. In 1972, he founded Faith Works Company which was mainly construction and employed several jobless people

in his city. He and Alice were part of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal Prayer Group and served as lay ministers. He served as a lecturer at St. Alfred's in Taylor, MI for over 40 years.

He loved following hockey, football, and baseball - whether professional, college or watching his grands play. His hobbies included playing racquetball, pickleball, golfing, and traveling. In the early years, traveling with seven children meant camping on the dunes of Lake Michigan telling stories, and singing around a campfire. Later in life, he and his wife traveled around the world using airline flight benefits. He loved talking to the flight attendants bragging about his wife and the endeavors of his children. Norm loved to network and would talk to anyone and everyone. He was known to impart advice with faith and wisdom.

He will be remembered as a man who left a legacy of family and stressed the importance of faith and commitment.

FOREST PARK VISITORS WRISTBANDS

Visitors unaccompanied by Forest Park residents must wear wristbands when using park recreational facilities (pool, mini-golf, etc.).

The wristbands are normally available in the park office (2 per family and additional bands may be requested). The bands stretch but if they are not large enough you may pin them to clothing, attach them to a key chain or just bring them along.

Please remember that all owners are responsible for their visitors who must comply with all Forest Park Rules & Regulations.



HAZARDOUS WASTE

Lee County has very strict regulations regarding hazardous material disposal. The Board voted to approve the initiative to have all residents place paint, pesticides, chemicals, florescent bulbs and gas bottles at curbside.

Park employees will pick up these materials on Tuesday and Friday and log them in. These articles will be stored and disposed of in the appropriate manner by staff members.

The rules and regulations have been changed to reflect the process.

GREEN TREE STICKER

There is a little green tree sticker available in the office that goes on the **LEFT SIDE OF YOUR BACK WINDOW** of your car. All residents with automobiles should have this highly visible authorization to be in the Park. This will help the safety patrol on their nightly rounds. If you are temporary resident and don't want any stickers on your window, then scotch tape it there while you are here.

The recycle truck comes on Fridays.

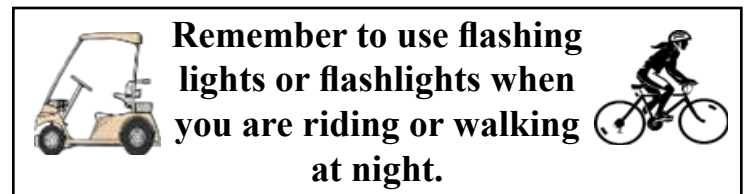


ALUMINUM CAN RECYCLE
